

## CLOSET ORGANIZER

Let Southern Lumber help you create the space you need  
with a pre-cut Closet Organizer.

### LIST OF NEEDED STEPS:

1. Carefully measure all affected walls.
2. Determine lengths of closet poles needed.
3. Select material to be used i.e. Melamine, Particle Board, or Plywood.
4. Design closet organizer layout (Remember to allow for proper lengths of closet pole needed, as well as open shelves and drawers that will be needed).
5. Once layout is complete this will help you to determine proper quantities of shelf standards and shelf clips.
6. Select proper fasteners based on layout of unit as well as wall make-up.
7. Once ready to start project first remove old shelving, Closet poles, and fittings.
8. Clean and prep wall(s) as needed.
9. To start assembly make sure that you have a flat level surface large enough to complete the building process.
